

HHES School Community Council Focuses on Literacy: Laser-like!

SCC approved two action items last night, 10/12/20:

- 1) To allocate TSSA \$\$ from legislature, \$26,417, for technology.
- 2) Allocate some carryover \$\$ for **BTS Arts-Literacy Integration** and the rest, \$17,094 for technology.

That means there is \$43,511 for technology. We know that our fifth 6th grade class needs some things and so does 3rd grade.

CTL's will work with Mr. Truesdell, ASAP (tomorrow) and after the break to order things for your teams. We want to get these materials in classrooms so that teachers and students have these resources this year.

Reminder: Please **wisely use the aides** that our TG \$\$ was used to purchase re: **literacy assistance** in support of our school improvement, academic goal to increase student **reading proficiency in every classroom** by 2-4% this school year. Every grade was allotted RTI-remediation- aide time, with K-2nd emphasis. \$101,764 was allocated by SCC for this last Spring.

Our 1st BER (**Building Effective Readers**) Cohort for 2020-21 was conducted under Mrs. Garrett's and Mrs. Porter's direction in coordination with ASD Curriculum, with the six 1st grade teachers on Monday. More training is coming to the other teams this Fall as well. Mrs. Garrett will share info again. SCC allocated \$12,838 for this training, subs, the **writing workshop** with Brad Wilcox from BYU and CITES **Literacy** Conference this Spring.

All totaled, that is \$177,907 allocated by the HHES Community Council for **literacy improvement**, learning, instruction, remediation, integration and technology for the 2020-2021 school year. This is a great investment in our teachers and students. We are **laser-like focused on literacy progress and proficiency** at HHES.

As we concentrate on **effective reading instruction**, including:

- *Guided Reading and
- *Wonders' instruction,
- *teaming,
- *synergizing our efforts and
- *using technology and training to enhance what we are doing,
- *progress monitoring and assessing.....

.....this will result in enhanced **STUDENT LEARNING at HHES**. We will see this happen in **reading, writing**, math, science and all other areas of learning in our PLC.
